TEMPLE JUDAH YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP FUND GUIDELINES & CRITERIA

1. The Temple Judah Youth Scholarship Committee will meet as needed for the purposes of modifying guidelines, reviewing applications, and distributing funds.
2. Applicant's family must be Temple Judah members in good standing
3. Applicants must be students in grades K-12
4. Applications will be for activities which enhance Jewish education and awareness not provided in the onsite Temple Judah programs or Temple Judah youth organizations.
 - A. Trips to Israel, Jewish camps, conclaves (chavurahs), and special Jewish events
5. Grants will be decided based on merit or financial need
6. Higher priority will be given to:
 - A. Individuals and their families who have been active in the Temple Judah community (i.e. committees, community service, programming)
 - B. Individuals with matching funds
 - C. Individuals who have not received prior grants
 - D. Applications in the order they are received
7. **Providing funds are available**, disbursements will follow these guidelines:
 - A. For conclaves (chavurahs), up to half the registration fee per event, to a maximum of \$250 per person per year, and up to half the transportation cost per event to a maximum of \$250 per year. Group (3 or greater) travel cost may be applied for by adult sponsor to a maximum of \$350 per event
 - B. For camp, approximately \$250 per week
 - C. For Israel trips \$1,000-\$1,500
